The top five students who raised the most have been rewarded with an electric scooter each.

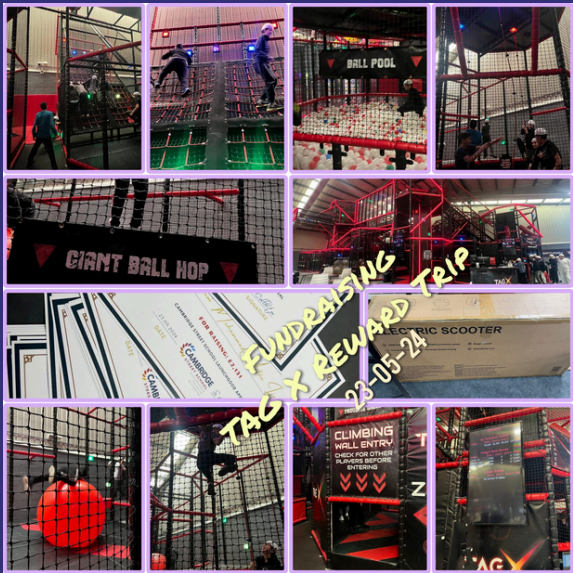
